

Fee Explanation

- **Container Pricing:** Apex Group, Inc. charges a flat fee per haul for all container rentals. This fee includes all delivery, hauling, and dumping charges.
- **Reset Fee:** A reset fee will be charged each time a new container is set. The reset fee is equal to the initial cost of the container.
- **Over Tonnage:** All containers have weight limitations prescribed according to container size. An over tonnage fee will be assessed for each ton over the restricted weight limit.
- **Disallowed Items:** If any hazardous materials or disallowed items are found in a container, the customer will be notified and charged for their disposal.
- **Dead Run Fee:** If Apex Group, Inc. attempts but is unable to access a container scheduled for pick-up a fee will be charged. The same policy applies for untimely cancelled orders that Apex Group, Inc. attempted to deliver a container.
- **Return Check Policy:** A fee will be charged for all returned checks.
- **Container Damage:** The customer is responsible for any damage to the container beyond normal wear and tear. The charge for damages will be billed to the customer account.
- **Over Due Accounts:** If accounts become habitually overdue Apex Group, reserves the right to require payment on delivery.
- **Finance Charge:** A monthly finance charge will be enforced if accounts are delinquent.

Payment Options:

All customers are invoiced daily. Statements are sent out on the 15th and last day of each month. Payment is due upon receipt of the statement. The following methods of payment are accepted: Visa, MasterCard, check, money order, or cash.
